FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's parent was notified by the Principal of John I. Leonard Community High School that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on December 23, 2004. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parent was notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on January 21, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parent of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. No hearing request has been received in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated January 21, 2005, to wit:

Possession of a knife while on the campus of John I. Leonard High School on
December 22, 2004

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed.  is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from January 24, 2005. Your son may choose to continue educational services during his expulsion

period at the ACS site. However, if your son is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

Dear Custodial Parent/Guardian:

On 12/23/2004 your son/daughter/ward was rendered a ten (10) day suspension as documented by my letter to you, a copy of which is attached.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.23(6)(c), which authorizes the School Board to decide cases recommended for expulsion, I have this date recommended to the Expulsion Screening Committee that the School Board expel your son/daughter/ward from the public schools of Palm Beach County. My recommendation is based on substantial evidence available to me supporting the following serious misconduct.

On 12/21/04, before school, students approached an administrator to say that Juan was having a problem with his ex-girlfriend. The students reported that [redacted] would not leave the girl alone. The administrator spoke to [redacted] and asked him to leave the area, which [redacted] did. On 12/22/04, [redacted] came onto John I. Leonard campus with a 3 1/2 inch blade knife. Several students came to the dean's office to report that [redacted] was in the cafeteria courtyard and he was pushing the female student. [redacted] then pushed the ex-girlfriend into the corner, took out the knife, opened the blade and said, "I'm going to hurt your boyfriend." The female student informed an administrator that [redacted] had the knife in his pocket. I asked [redacted] if he had a knife, he stated he did and handed me the knife. [redacted] also showed the knife to another female student. When she told him to put it away he said, "why, are you scared?" [redacted] stated that the knife belonged to his mother and that he is despondent over the break up with this girl.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.33(8), the Superintendent may extend the ten (10) day suspension until the date the School Board Meeting at which time the School Board will act on the Expulsion.

As of 01/24/2005, your son/daughter/ward is assigned to the Department of Alternative Education.

ON 12/22/04 AT 0830 HRS. THIS OFFICER WAS ASKED TO RESPOND TO THE DEANS OFFICE AT JOHN LEONARD HIGH SCHOOL FOR A STUDENT PROBLEM. UPON ARRIVAL I MET WITH STUDENT [REDACTED] WHO RELATED THE FOLLOWING. [REDACTED] SAID HE CAME TO JOHN LEONARD HIGH SCHOOL TODAY WITH A KNIFE (THE KNIFES BLADE OVER 3.75 INCHES LONG). HE IS DESPONDENT OVER A BREAK UP WITH HIS GIRL FRIEND AND MADE THREATS TO HARM THE GIRL AND HER NEW BOY FRIEND. HE CLAIMS TO BE DEPRESSED AND SAYS HE HAS BEEN TREATED FOR MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES IN THE PAST AND HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED AS HAVING A BIPOLAR DISORDER. HE SAID HE IS OBSESSED WITH HIS X-GIRLFRIEND AND CANNOT CONTROL THIS OBSESSION.
