Dear members of the School Board Of Palm Beach County,

We are writing this letter to request your consideration to return our son, [REDACTED] to the regular school system as soon as possible. [REDACTED] was expelled from Palm Beach Central High School in December 2003 for having a knife in his back pack. Although he did not use the knife to threaten anyone, he did in any case, carry it onto school grounds, which is a serious violation of school policy. We are not going to discuss at this time the merits of the case or as to why he had the knife with him, but simply want to convey that [REDACTED] has since learned and now understands fully, the consequences of such reckless behavior. [REDACTED] has been attending an alternative school, ACS at Wellington Boys & Girls Club, for the past 13 months, where he was to serve only a 12 month expulsion, and has been looking forward to and is most eager to getting back to a regular school environment as fast as possible. In January 2004, we choose to accept Palm Beach Central Board's recommendation for a 12 month expulsion and opted NOT to pursue an expulsion hearing and instead, have [REDACTED] begin his 12 month expulsion immediately. We, as caring and concerned parents, ask that you please review the enclosed package and background information in your consideration to return [REDACTED] to the regular school system as soon as possible..

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We would like to provide you with some background on [REDACTED] unique situation for your consideration in assessing [REDACTED] reinstatement.

If you are not already familiar with the infraction which caused this situation, please let me summarize. On December 3rd, 2004 [REDACTED] was arrested at Palm Beach Central High School for having a knife in his backpack. He did not use it or pull out for any purpose, but he did have it in his back pack. After the arrest, he indicated to me and the school police officer that he had been threatened by another student and that several of his friends later told him that the student who threatened him was carrying a knife and was going to stab [REDACTED] in school. I won't discuss any further the merits of what happened at that time other than to say the [REDACTED] absolutely showed extremely poor judgment and complete indiscretion in how he chose to deal with the situation at that time. Above all the obvious pain this caused our family, considering the closeness of the relationship the three of us have enjoyed, the worst pain what that [REDACTED] ever brought this threat to our attention, or that of the school's administration and chose instead, to deal with it in such a destructive and reckless manner. [REDACTED] was subsequently expelled from school and was placed in an alternative education setting. He begun his one year expulsion on January 12, 2004 - just over 13 months ago.

The above, represent the factual basis which have brought us to this point.

Now I'd like to share with you some thoughts and insights which I ask that you consider in evaluating our request for reinstatement.

[REDACTED] is not, what I assume to be the typical case which comes before you for these types of hearings. I'd like to now list some factors to consider;

- [REDACTED] is a member of a loving, supportive, stable family. My wife, [REDACTED] and I, have been married for almost 23 years. His paternal grandparents have been married for 46 years and his maternal were married till death did them part. I have been with the same corporation, IBM, for 24 years, currently serve as a Red Cross volunteer (and ironically spend three solid days working at Palm Beach Central High during each of the two recent hurricanes) and are active members of our church and other local community organizations.
- [REDACTED] suffers from a rare combination of two psychological disorders; an aggressive case of ADD/HD, which most of you are probably familiar with to some degree, as well as Tourette's syndrome.
  - Now, each of these disorders in of themselves can generally be managed and controlled with medication and counseling to a fairly effective degree. However, in the rare instances in which an individual suffers from both, as with [REDACTED] this situation becomes much more difficult to manage. I am no doctor, but here is a summary of having these two disorders. The medication to treat one disorder, irritates and intensifies the other so that if you treat the Tourette's, the ADD goes off the chart and makes school work almost impossible to focus on. If you treat the ADD, then Tourette's becomes significantly more troublesome. There are long periods of trying to find the right mix of medications to achieve a balanced treatment for these two disorders. Once the balance is found, it becomes manageable - for a while, until he enters a growth spurt then, we start all over again to find the proper mixture. We were in the midst of one such medicinal transitional periods, with [REDACTED] 'judgment' was obviously

impaired, when the infraction occurred. [REDACTED] is not and has never been a violent or abusive person, actually, he is quite the contrary - he has even played guitar in our local church's choir ministry. To make matters worse, for most of the past year and a half [REDACTED] had been misdiagnosed by his previous doctor and has been on the wrong medication which further aggravated his psychological state. We have since changed his doctor(s) who has prescribed the proper medication and [REDACTED] has shown absolute improvement - please refer to attached note from Dr. Greenfield for more details. I believe you are probably already somewhat familiar with ADD, but you may not know about Tourette's. Let me provide you with a brief nonmedical description of this disorder. Tourette's has many manifestations, but is probably most well know as the disorder which makes people shout out words or obscenities in a completely uncontrolled manner. Fortunately [REDACTED] case of Tourette's is not a severe one, but he has had to suffer through the embarrassment it has caused him since he was fairly young - we have home videos which show signs of it since he was around 5 or six year old, although we were not aware of it at that time. We though he just got excited at times and believe it was the ADD. Because of Tourette's [REDACTED] has had to cope and deal with the following physical manifestations of Tourette's - these are not all that he has had, just the ones I can vividly remember while writing these notes. They are in no particular order and most often he'll exhibit a combination of any two or three of the following;

- Softly blowing - early on through the mouth, but lately through the nose
  - Blinking hard for several seconds then ,
  - Rolling the eyes upwards towards the back of his head
  - Hard twitching of his head
  - Appearing to yawn when focusing intently and looking directly at someone
  - Coughing
  - Wide opening of his mouth
  - Snapping his fingers hard on one or both hands (even causing blisters)
  - Continuous spitting while standing on grass
  - Shaking his hands for several seconds very frequently
  - Hopping -he'll be standing in line, then suddenly will hop twice - this was a source of great discomfort/embarrassment
  - Shaking his head side to side very fast
  - Curling his lips
  - Sticking his tongue out
  - And many vocalizations from a soft grunting sound to constant coughing-like sounds.
- The above were particularly evident when he is in a stressful situation - as in the days leading up to a big test or other significant events. Please remember that this does not 'Go Away' and [REDACTED] continues to struggle and deal with the above, although he has learned to 'hide' some of them to a certain degree until he is alone - try and imagine the embarrassment the above can cause a teenager in our schools and think of how cruel some kids can be when they sense a weakness ..... I won't even go there !!!!
  - As parents, we have always been very hands-on [REDACTED] has always been very active in sports and other activities. From the time he was 4 years old, I would not simply drop him off at practice, but I would become a coach as well. In the last 12 years or so, I have been head or assistant coach in soccer, basketball, football and baseball. In fact, for most of the last six

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years since we moved to Florida, I have been a baseball coach right here in the town of Wellington. [REDACTED] has also played for the Palm Beach Central High Varsity Baseball team. In addition to sports, I have been a Scout Master, karate dad, kid taxi driver and midnight chaperone among many many other things - just so [REDACTED] and I could spend as much time together as possible.

- As he entered Wellington High School and weeks turned to months and semesters, we were relieved to see that only his grades continued to suffer - as is normal in ADD children. He has always struggled with grades and not due to a lack of effort, but that he just had to work that much harder than others simply to get C's. If he got a B, we went out to dinner as a family to celebrate - that was our custom. He tries so hard....
- Throughout this entire time, there was never an episode in which [REDACTED] was involved in any violent activity. He was a well adjusted child dealing with ADD/HD and Tourette's.
- All was well until the Fall of 2003 when, as a result of the redistricting to include the new high school, he was forced to transfer to Palm Beach Central High School. It wasn't long before [REDACTED] was telling us at dinner time about some of the kids that went to this new school and how many of the students were being terrorized by these kids. We made a point of discussing school every night and I was appalled to hear what [REDACTED] was telling me about some of the acts these kids were conducting on school grounds and how nothing seemed to be done about it.... I also discussed these issues with other students and parents. The stories just kept getting worse and worse. Shortly after, [REDACTED] told us of how he got mugged by some kids in the boys room who then stole his lunch money - he did not tell us at this time the one of them pulled a knife on him, we found that out much later.....
- Just as I was thinking I ought to go in and speak with the principal, I read the announcement that the original principal (Ms. Shirley ?) was being reassigned and a new principal, Dr. Saltzman, was coming in to in affect 'clean up' the school. Meanwhile the stories from [REDACTED] his friends kept getting more and more serious about the conduct of some of these kids that were being brought in from the surrounding areas. Everyday, more and more stories about how the environment was totally out of control and how kids were too afraid to even tell anyone about what they were seeing. This time, [REDACTED] tells us that some kids roughed him up while he was at a vending machine area - again he did not tell us that one of them pulled a knife on him. I was thinking it was just the same high school rough housing that's part of any high school experience. I could not have been more wrong.
- I strongly encouraged [REDACTED] to contact the school administrators or teachers and report what was going on not only to him personally, but what was going on around him generally. He looked at me and said, "Dad, you don't do that any more. If you do, those kids find out about it the next day and then you're dead". This concerned me greatly.
- The stories in the newspapers and news programs kept growing and growing and we were really concerned. But in the end, we sort of just had to accept it and hoped and prayed that the new principle would clean up the horrible environment the kids had to endure.
- In the last six years since coming to Florida, through rezoning and progression, [REDACTED] has now attended six different Schools (see below). We are all eager to provide him with some sort of stability as he prepares to complete his high school experience.
  - Panther Run
  - Wellington Landings
  - Polo Park

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- Wellington High School
- Palm Beach Central
- ACS, Wellington

I am including several attachments in this package which I believe make a compelling case to have [REDACTED] return to the regular school system as soon as possible. Here is a summary on each of the attachments for your review;

- A letter from [REDACTED] addressed directly to this Board expressing his remorsefulness and full recognition of what he did and of how wrong and inappropriate it was. I believe [REDACTED] has paid an extremely high price for what he did, but he has accepted it and, with your concurrence, is now ready and eager to assimilate himself back into the regular student body as soon as possible.
- A letter from Mr. Kevin McLeod, Principal at ACS, the alternative school [REDACTED] has been serving his expulsion, located in Wellington, stating, "ACS Wellington staff has seen a positive turnaround in [REDACTED] since his return from important care. [REDACTED] has presented a unique case, since his medication change, his grades and behavior has improved. [REDACTED] was identified as the most improved student at Wellington. We attribute the change to his parental and medical support". Refer to attached letter.
- He is the recent recipient of the "MOST IMPROVED ASSOCIATE" Award given by Mr. McLeod, Principal ACS. Refer to attached award.
- A letter from Dr. Johnathan C. Greenfield, MD, PA (Psychiatry) who is currently treating [REDACTED] for his ADD/HD and Tourette's syndrome. Dr. Greenfield has been treating [REDACTED] since late 2004 when he discovered that [REDACTED] had prior been erroneously diagnosed and had been improperly medicated for several years, which was aggravating his psychological condition this entire time. Dr. Greenfield writes that, "Since receiving proper treatment and being placed on the appropriate medication, [REDACTED] has made a complete turnaround in terms of his behavior, attitude and school performance. Having been diagnosed correctly and now being placed on the correct medication, the school, his parents as well as myself see the tremendous change in progress that he has made in the last several months. I feel that it would be beneficial to this young man to normalize his life as much as possible and return him to a regular school setting so that he can benefit from both the academic as well as the social environment. It is my opinion at this time that [REDACTED] poses no threat to either himself or to the faculty and students, should he be returned to his regular school curriculum and setting". Refer to attached letter.
- A letter from my attorney, Mr. Kenneth D. Lemoine, indicating that there was an agreement with the previous School Board attorney, Corey Smith, that [REDACTED] would be allowed to return back to the regular Palm Beach school system after a one year expulsion period, which would begin in January 2004, if we opted to concur with the school's recommendation of a one year expulsion, which we did. We were instructed by Mr. Smith in the presence of my attorney as well several members of the Palm Beach Central School board, that if we did not contest their recommendation for a one year expulsion and not request an expulsion hearing, which would be scheduled in May 2004, that the expulsion period would begin immediately (January 12, 2004) as opposed to May 2004. We [REDACTED] and I (parents) and our attorney) agreed to not contest the



school's recommendation and we all ended the meeting with the understanding that [REDACTED] expulsion would be over in January 2005. Refer to attached letter.

- A letter written by [REDACTED] to us, his parents, shortly after the incident in December 2003.
- We arranged to have [REDACTED] attend a 'Consequences of Crime Program' which he successfully completed. Refer to attached certificate.
- We requested that [REDACTED] take a 'Jail Tour' through the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office. See completion
- We had [REDACTED] perform 25 hours community service. Refer to attached log (although it's not complete)
- A letter that [REDACTED] wrote to the officer who handled his legal case, where [REDACTED] expresses his desire to become a Doctor. Refer to attached letter.
- His last report card.

In conclusion, [REDACTED] knows what he did was absolutely wrong and now fully understands and appreciates why such behavior is not tolerated not only in school specifically, but in society in general. [REDACTED] paid an extremely steep price for this understanding. We submit to this board, that no further benefits can be achieved by keeping [REDACTED] in the alternative school system for any additional length of time and ask that you please authorize his return to the regular school system as soon as possible.

Although I did not threaten anyone with it, I know that what I did was an extremely bad thing to do but, I also know I'd love nothing more than to go back to Palm Beach Central now that I have served thirteen months on my one year expulsion period. I love the school and have a lot of school spirit and have a lot of friends that attend Palm Beach Central. I am now currently attending ACS Alternative Schooling which is held over at the Boys and Girls club in Wellington. I have been there for over a year now, and have worked on and improved my behavior and attitude. I have straightened out and learned my lesson. One of the things I did was a jail tour and hope to never walk through those doors again. I now go to school as I mentioned before, and feel very out of place, I feel like I don't belong there because I really miss my old school. I am doing pretty well grade wise, and behavior wise pretty well too. But I would like to know, of course with your permission, if I could go back to Palm Beach Central. I'd really love that so much, I mean I have really changed and I'd like to add that I am extremely sorry for what I did and I don't blame you one bit for expelling me, but I'd like to know if I could attend Palm Beach Central as soon as possible if the School Board allows. I know what I did not only makes the school look bad, myself, but it also made you look bad because people think you have crazy kids in your school and I'm sure there are, I mean I was held up in the bathroom with knives on two occasions, so I know all about that and your just trying to get that madness out of there, which I totally agree with you on. I really want you to know that I'm not one of those kids, I'm really, honestly, fullheartedly one of the kids who made a really big and bad mistake and I apologize sincerely to everyone. I really mean it, so could you please give me one more shot at going back to the one school I actually liked attending because I felt it was great academically and friendly. So can I please have just one more chance sirs, I am willing to do what it takes to become a successful student at Palm Beach Central. Please understand, that I just really honestly made a big mistake and am not really what you think I am.

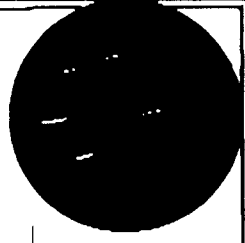



And I no that im gonna change because i wanna become very good friends again or should I say best buds with my true best bud my dad and I wanna keep the relationship I used to have with my mom I just hope that they will like let me back in to the family.

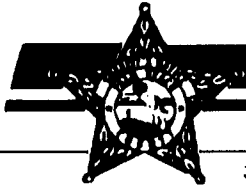

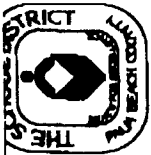
Dear officer,
