**FINAL ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent's parent was notified by the Principal of Santaluces High School that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on February 3, 2005. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parent was notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on February 11, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parent of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. No hearing request has been received in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated February 11, 2005, to wit:

Sale and/or distribution of marijuana while on the campus of Santaluces High School on February 1, 2005.

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed. [REDACTED] is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from February 16, 2005. Respondent may choose to continue educational services during his

expulsion period at the ACS site. However, if Respondent is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

On 02/01/2005 your son/daughter/ward was rendered a ten (10) day suspension as documented by my letter to you, a copy of which is attached.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.23(6)(c), which authorizes the School Board to decide cases recommended for expulsion, I have this date recommended to the Expulsion Screening Committee that the School Board expel your son/daughter/ward from the public schools of Palm Beach County. My recommendation is based on substantial evidence available to me supporting the following serious misconduct.

The student has a history of sale and possession of drugs according to middle school records.

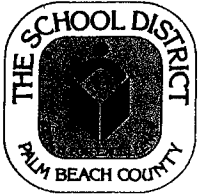

**NOTICE OF RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION**

Your request must be received by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, a hearing officer will be appointed pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.81(1)(e). If you do not request a hearing, this recommendation will become final.

Your son may receive educational services at the ACS Transition Program during this expulsion due process. If you have any questions regarding the expulsion due process or the educational services available at the ACS Intensive Site, please contact the Office of the Chief Academic Officer at 561-649-6888.



On Tuesday, February 1, 2005 at approximately 1215 hours, I was on duty at Santaluces High School when Assistant Principal, Marie Difonte requested police officer assistance in her office. When I arrived at Ms. Difonte's office, she directed my attention to a small, clear plastic, Ziploc bag containing a green, leafy substance, which appeared to be marijuana and a blue Pyrex pipe on her desk. Ms. Difonte informed me the items were recovered from student, [REDACTED] at the school center. Officer Anthony Pilallis of the Palm Beach County School District Police asked [REDACTED] here he purchased the suspected Marijuana. [REDACTED] replied, a friend of his named [REDACTED] I asked [REDACTED] who at the time was sitting in Ms. Difonte's office, to come to my office at the school center. In my office, I subjected a small sample of the suspected marijuana and a sample of the residue that I collected from the pipe's bowl to Nark #8 Duquenois Reagent, Marijuana-Hashish-THC tests. The substance's test results were positive (blue), indicative of THC. I then recited the Miranda Rights Warnings to [REDACTED]. He advised me that he understood his Constitutional Rights and he signed the Miranda Rights form. [REDACTED] agreed to give me a sworn, written statement as to what happened. In his statement [REDACTED] advised that he was in the bathroom when one of the Supervision people found him smoking. The supervision person then took [REDACTED] to the office where he was searched and the Marijuana was discovered by Ms. Difonte. [REDACTED] also told me he did not want to name the person who sold him the Marijuana in the sworn, written statement.

I obtained a sworn, written statement from Patrick J. Horvath (Supervision Personnel); wherein he stated that he was checking the restrooms in the 4000 Building, after 1st lunch. Upon entering the Boy's bathroom, Mr. Horvath noticed a student standing in the last stall. Mr. Horvath advised that he stood there for a moment and heard a lighter clicking a number of times. As he approached the stall, he smelled smoke. Mr. Horvath then told the student, later identified as [REDACTED] to come out of the stall. Mr. Horvath then escorted [REDACTED] to Student Services, where Ms. Difonte directed [REDACTED] to empty his pockets. [REDACTED] removed a Ziploc bag containing a green, leafy substance, a bowl, and two lighters.

I photographed and processed the Marijuana and the Pyrex pipe into evidence. The Marijuana weighed approximately 4.1 grams.

While still conducting my investigation into [REDACTED] at approximately 1245 hours, Officer Pilallis arrived at my office at the school center; he was accompanied by student/defendant John [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). Officer Pilallis advised that he had found [REDACTED] in the courtyard and asked [REDACTED] to accompany him to his office, which [REDACTED] voluntarily did. Once in Officer Pilallis' office at the school center, [REDACTED] was asked by Officer Pilallis if there was something that he wanted

to tell him. [REDACTED] replied without hesitation, "I sold weed to [REDACTED]. At this point, Officer Pilallis read [REDACTED] his Miranda Rights. [REDACTED] advised that he understood his Constitutional Rights and signed the Miranda Rights form. [REDACTED] agreed to give Officer Pilallis a sworn, written statement; wherein he admitted that on Friday, January 28, 2005, he was approached by [REDACTED] at school. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if he could get him some weed. [REDACTED] told him, "Yes". [REDACTED] handed [REDACTED] \$50.00 at that time and said he wanted an "eighth". I further developed probable cause to believe [REDACTED] committed the felony offense of Sale of Marijuana (1000 feet of school), whereby; he did unlawfully and knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver or possess with intent to sell, manufacture or deliver cannabis, commonly known as marijuana, or material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contained cannabis, a controlled substance in, on, or within 1000 feet of the real property comprising a public or private elementary, middle or secondary school, between the hours of 0600 and 0000 hours, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(1)(c)2.

I prepared a Juvenile Referral and Probable Cause Affidavit requesting a Capias from the Palm Beach County State Attorney's office. I notified [REDACTED] mother about the criminal charges that were being filed. An NCIC background check revealed no evidence that [REDACTED] had a prior criminal history. Considering the nature of the charges against him, [REDACTED] could not be accepted into the Youth Court program and these charges will be filed with the Palm Beach County State Attorney's office. 

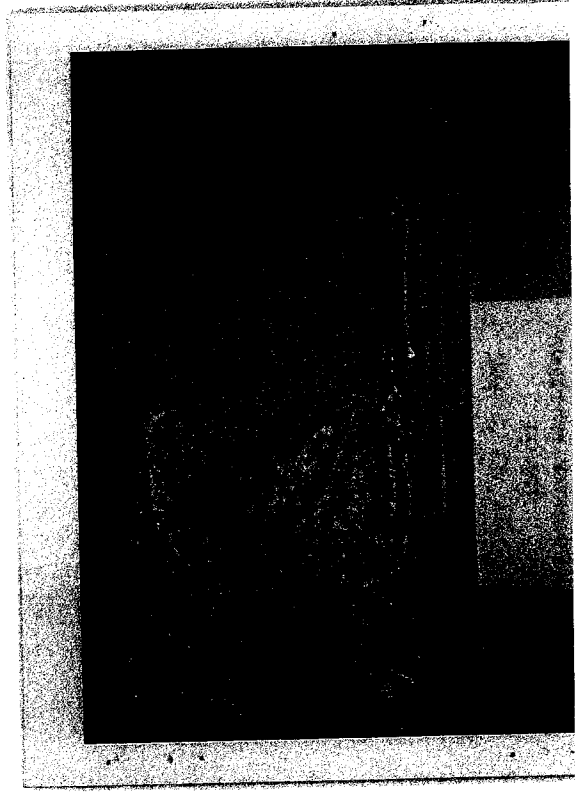
