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**FINAL ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent's parents were notified by the Principal of Forest Hill High School that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on January 31, 2005. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parents were notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on February 11, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parents of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. No hearing request has been received in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated February 11, 2005, to wit:

Sale and/or distribution of marijuana to an undercover officer while on the campus of Forest Hill High School on January 27, 2005.

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed.  is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from February 10, 2005. Respondent may choose to continue educational services during her

expulsion period at the ACS site. However, if Respondent is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

On 01/27/2005 your son/daughter/ward was rendered a ten (10) day suspension as documented by my letter to you, a copy of which is attached.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.23(6)(c), which authorizes the School Board to decide cases recommended for expulsion, I have this date recommended to the Expulsion Screening Committee that the School Board expel your son/daughter/ward from the public schools of Palm Beach County. My recommendation is based on substantial evidence available to me supporting the following serious misconduct.

On January 27, 2005 [REDACTED] was arrested and charged with conspiracy to sell marijuana to an undercover P.O. He was transported to the Juvenile Assessment Center.

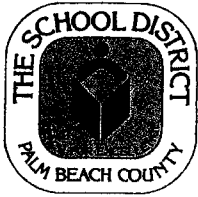

This decision is based upon the following action:

Sale and/or distribution of marijuana to an undercover officer while on the campus of Forest Hill High School on January 27, 2005..

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.569, you have the right to an administrative hearing. Your request must be received by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, a hearing officer will be appointed pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.81(1)(e). If you do not request a hearing, this recommendation will become final.

Your daughter may receive educational services at the ACS Transition Program during this expulsion due process. If you have any questions regarding the expulsion due process or the educational services available at the ACS Intensive Site, please contact the Office of the Chief Academic Officer at 561-649-6888.



ON NOVEMBER 30, 2004, AT 0930 HOURS, I WAS WORKING IN AN UNDERCOVER CAPACITY AT 6901 PARKER AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FORESTHILL COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL. WHILE AT MY 5TH HOUR CLASS, TEAM SPORTS, I MET [REDACTED] WHITE FEMALE. SHE SAID SHE WAS SENT TO A PROGRAM BECAUSE SHE GOT INTO A LOT OF TROUBLE IN SCHOOL. I ASKED [REDACTED] IF SHE COULD HOOK ME WITH UP WITH SOME WEED ANYWAY. I ALSO TOLD [REDACTED] I DID COKE AND SHE SAID, "DO YOU DO BUMP," WHICH IS ANOTHER TERM FOR SNORTING COCAINE. [REDACTED] ALSO ASKED, "DO YOU DO PILLS?" I SAID, "YES." SHE ASKED WHAT I USED AND I SAID, "ECSTASY, XANIE BARS, XANAX". I TOLD [REDACTED] I HAD FRIENDS COMING DOWN FROM TALLAHASSEE AND THEY WOULD WANT SOME. [REDACTED] THEN SAID, "I JUST GOT RID OF 50 XANIES YESTERDAY BUT I AM GETTING 100 MORE ON FRIDAY." I ASKED HER TO GET ME 50 XANIES AND ASKED HOW MUCH WOULD EACH ONE BE. I TOLD [REDACTED] I HAD BOUGHT XANIES AT JOHN I. LEONARD HIGH SCHOOL. I TOLD HER I BOUGHT IT FOR \$4 DOLLARS EACH. [REDACTED] "FOR YOU, I GIVE IT TO YOU FOR \$2 DOLLARS EACH. I CAN ALSO GET YOU SOME X, SOME GOOD SHIT FROM HONDORUS. I ASKED IF HE COULD GET ME SOME MARIJUANA. [REDACTED] SAID HER BROTHER, [REDACTED] SELLS MARIJUANA. SHE SAID HER BROTHER SELLS SOME RAGS AND SOME GOOD SHIT. TOMORROW, WE ARE GOING TO HAVE A LITTLE PARTY DRINK AND I AM GOING TO GET MY HAIR BRAIDED. THERE IS A GUY WHO IS GOING TO BE THERE AND HE IS GOING TO HAVE SOME CRIPPY. [REDACTED] ALSO SAID, "MY BROTHER AND THIS GUY GET THEIR STUFF FROM THE SAME GUY." I ASKED IF THE GUY WHO IS GOING TO BE THERE GOES TO THE SCHOOL. SHE SAID, "NO." [REDACTED] SAID SHE USE TO PUSH A LOT OF STUFF THROUGH THE SCHOOL BUT WHEN SHE LEFT FOR TWO MONTHS WAS WHEN SHE FELL OFF BUT SHE SAID SHE IS GOING TO BUILD HER WAY UP AGAIN. [REDACTED] GAVE ME HER PHONE NUMBER AND I GAVE HER THE PHONE NUMBER TO MY PBSO ISSUED CELL PHONE. AFTER THAT, I LEFT THE CAMPUS.

AT 1943 HOURS, I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL ON MY PBSO ISSUED PHONE CALL FROM [REDACTED] PHONE NUMBER OF [REDACTED] WAS TELLING ME ABOUT A HEATED VERBAL CONFRONTATION SHE AND HER FRIENDS HAD WITH THE SAME BLACK FEMALE WHO MAYBE A FRESHMAN. I ASKED WHAT WAS THE FIGHT ABOUT AND SHE SAID THE BLACK FEMALE TRIED HER FRIEND. [REDACTED] SAID, "SHE WAS AT WORK AND WAS GETTING BUSY BUT WOULD BE OFF AT 11 P.M. (2300 HOURS). I TOLD HER TO CALL ME BECAUSE SHE DID NOT KNOW IF SHE WAS GOING TO GO TO SCHOOL. AFTER I SPOKE TO HER, I CALLED THE SCHOOL OFFICER MUNEZ, HOWEVER,

I WAS UNABLE TO REACH HIM BUT I DID LEAVE A MESSAGE. I LEFT A MESSAGE LETTING HIM KNOW ABOUT THEIR BEING A FIGHT IN THE COURTYARD TOMORROW AT 120104 BETWEEN [REDACTED] FRIENDS AND SOME BLACK FEMALES. THE TIME IS UNKNOWN. THE REST OF THE EVENING WENT ON WITHOUT INCIDENT.

ON DECEMBER 02, 2004, AT ABOUT 1551 HOURS, I CALLED [REDACTED] AT PHONE NUMBER OF 561-[REDACTED] FROM MY PBSO ISSUED CELL PHONE. WE SPOKE ABOUT HER BEING MAD AT ME FOR NOT HANGING OUT. THEN, I ASKED HER IF SHE WOULD HAVE THE PILLS FOR ME TOMORROW ON DECEMBER 03, 2004. [REDACTED] SAID, "HOW MANY DO YOU WANT?" I SAID, "15". [REDACTED] SAID, "I'M GOING TO GET THEM AFTER SCHOOL." I TOLD HER TO CALL ME ONCE SHE DID AND IF WE CAN'T GET TOGETHER, I WILL GET THEM FROM HER ON MONDAY BECAUSE I WOULD BE GOING OUT OF TOWN FOR THE WEEKEND. [REDACTED] SAID SHE WOULD CALL ME AS SOON AS SHE GOT THEM. AT THAT POINT, THE CONVERSATION ENDED. I DID NOT RECEIVE ANY OTHER CALLS FROM [REDACTED] ON THIS DATE AND THE DAY ENDED WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.

ON DECEMBER 06, 2004, AT 1130 HOURS, I WAS WORKING IN AN UNDERCOVER CAPACITY AT 6901 PARKER AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FORESTHILL COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL, I WAS AT MY 5TH HOUR CLASS, TEAM SPORT WHEN I NOTICED MONTALBAN WAS IN CLASS. AFTER WE WERE DISMISSED TO LUNCH, I WAITED FOR [REDACTED] BECAUSE SHE ASKED ME TO. AT THAT MOMENT, I ASKED [REDACTED] IF SHE HAD THE PILLS SHE OFFERED TO GET ME. [REDACTED] SAID, "NO, I JUST SOLD 50 YESTERDAY. I AM GETTING SOME AFTER SCHOOL." WE WALKED OUT TO THE COURTYARD. AFTER A FEW MINUTES OF HANGING AROUND THE GYM AREA, I LEFT [REDACTED] AND WENT TO THE CAFETERIA.

ON DECEMBER 13, 2004, AT 1130 HOURS, I WAS WORKING IN AN UNDERCOVER CAPACITY AT 6901 PARKER AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FORESTHILL COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL. I WENT TO MY PEER COUNSELING CLASS, 4TH HOUR. DURING PEER COUNSELING, I NOTICED [REDACTED] WAS WORKING IN THE OFFICE. SHE ASKED ME TO ACCOMPANY HER TO DELIVER SOME PASSES IN THAT BUILDING.

WHILE GOING TO THE CLASSES, [REDACTED] ASKED ME WHAT I WAS GOING TO BE DOING THIS WEEKEND. I TOLD HER, "I MIGHT BE GOING OUT OF TOWN." [REDACTED] SAID SHE WAS ASKING BECAUSE A FRIEND OF HER'S WAS COMING FROM COLLEGE AND THEY WERE GOING TO HAVE A PARTY. [REDACTED] SAID THEY WOULD HAVE A LOT OF LOCAL ON AND SOME GUY WOULD BRING SOME CRIPPY, A TYPE OF MARIJUANA. AFTER THE CONVERSATION, WE GOT BACK TO THE OFFICE AND OUR CONVERSATION ENDED. THE CLASS ENDED AND I WENT TO MY 5TH HOUR CLASS.

ON DECEMBER 16, 2004, AT 1230 HOURS, I WAS WORKING IN AN UNDERCOVER CAPACITY AT 6901 PARKER AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FORESTHILL COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL. I WENT TO MY TEAM SPORT CLASS. DURING CLASS, I NOTICED THAT [REDACTED] WAS IN SCHOOL. THE CLASS ENDED WITHOUT INCIDENT.

AT LUNCH, I WALKED AROUND THE CAMPUS. WHEN I REACHED THE GYM LOBBY, I SAW [REDACTED] AND SHE WAVED ME OVER TO HER. [REDACTED] WAS HANGING OUT WITH ANOTHER WHITE FEMALE. I ASKED [REDACTED] ABOUT THE 15 XANAX BARS SHE HAD BEEN PROMISING TO GET ME. [REDACTED] SAID, "I GET PAID TODAY SO AFTER I CASH IT, I AM GOING TO PICK UP ABOUT 100 PILLS." SHE ALSO TOLD ME TO KEEP MY PHONE ON SO I COULD PICK IT UP. I AGREED AT THAT POINT. THE CONVERSATION ENDED AND WE WENT OUR SEPARATE WAYS.

AT ABOUT 1300 HOURS, I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL ON MY PBSO ISSUED CELL PHONE FROM [REDACTED] PHONE NUMBER OF 561-667-9834. [REDACTED] TOLD ME SHE WAS PICKING UP HER CHECK AND WAS ABOUT TO CASH IT. [REDACTED] SAID SHE WOULD CALL ME AS SOON AS SHE GOT THE PILLS. AT THAT POINT, THE CONVERSATION ENDED.

AT ABOUT 1630 HOURS, I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM [REDACTED] WHO SAID THE PERSON WHO IS GETTING THE PILLS WILL BE CALLING HER IN ABOUT FIVE MINUTES AND SHE WOULD CALL ME BACK.

AT 1930 HOURS, [REDACTED] CALLED AND SAID SHE WAS WAITING TO MEET THE

PERSON WHO WAS GOING TO GIVE HER THE XANAX. [REDACTED] SAID, "I AM SITTING HERE WAITING FOR THIS TRANVESTITE TO GET HERE." I TOLD HER I WAS BUSY COOKING FOR MY DAD. [REDACTED] ASKED ME IF I WAS GOING TO BE ABLE TO GET OUT OF THE HOUSE TO MEET HER. I TOLD HER I WOULD LET HER KNOW. AT THAT POINT, THE CONVERSATION ENDED.

AT 2043 HOURS, I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL ON MY PBSO ISSUED CELL PHONE FROM [REDACTED] SAID SHE HAD THE BARS I ASKED FOR. I ASKED HER TO BRING THEM TO SCHOOL WITH HER AND WOULD GET THEM FROM HER THERE. [REDACTED] SAID SHE WOULD BE IN SCHOOL BUT MIGHT BE IN LATE. AT THAT POINT, THE CONVERSATION. THE REST OF THE NIGHT ENDED WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.

ON DECEMBER 17, 2004, AT 1130 HOURS, I WAS WORKING IN AN UNDERCOVER CAPACITY AT 6901 PARKER AVENUE, WEST PALM BEACH, FORESTHILL COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL. WHILE AT MY 4TH HOUR CLASS, PEER COUNSELING, I SPOKE TO [REDACTED] WHITE FEMALE, WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY AGREED TO SELL ME 15 XANAX BARS. WHILE IN TALKING, [REDACTED] SAID, "HEY GIRL, I GOT SOME CANDY FOR YOU," REFERRING TO THE XANAX PILLS.

AFTER A FEW MINUTES, [REDACTED] AND I GOT PASSES FROM DEAN COLEMAN TO RUN TO INDIVIDUAL CLASSES. THERE WAS A PASS TO BE DELIVERED IN BUILDING 4 ON THE 3RD FLOOR. WHILE ON THE 3RD FLOOR, [REDACTED] SAID, "WE NEED TO GO TO THE BATHROOM TO DO THE DEAL." WE WENT TO THE BATHROOM OF THE 3RD FLOOR TO THE EAST HALL. I WENT INTO THE BATHROOM FIRST AND [REDACTED] CHECKED TO SEE IF ANYONE WAS COMING.

ONCE [REDACTED] ENTERED THE BATHROOM, SHE REACHED INTO HER FRONT RIGHT POCKET OF HER KAHKI SHORTS AND PULLED OUT A SMALL CLEAR PLASTIC BAG THAT APPEARED TO BE THE PLASTIC COVER OF A CIGARETTE BOX OR PACK. THE PLASTIC BAG CONTAINED SEVERAL XANAX BARS. [REDACTED] SAID IF I ONLY WANTED 15 XANAX BARS. I SAID, "YES." [REDACTED] COUNTED THE BARS OUT AND PUT THEM IN MY HAND AS SHE DID. I SAID, "NOW I HAVE TO FIGURE OUT WHERE I AM GOING TO PUT THEM. [REDACTED] OFFERED TO GIVE ME THE PLASTIC BAG BY SAYING "DO YOU WANT TO PUT IT IN THIS?" I SAID, "SURE." [REDACTED] HANDED THE BAG AFTER SHE TOOK OUT THE REMAINING PILLS, APPROXIMATELY FIVE XANAX PILLS AND KEPT THEM. I PUT THE XANAX BARS IN THE BAG AND THEN IN MY WALLET, I GAVE [REDACTED] \$30 DOLLARS, THE AGREED AMOUNT PROVIDED BY PBSO INVESTIGATIVE FUNDS, SERIAL NUMBER FOR THE TWENTY DOLLAR BILL #EE51291794A, TEN DOLLAR BILL, DL52587560A. ONCE WE MADE THE EXCHANGE, [REDACTED] AND I WENT OUT OF THE BATHROOM AND HEADED TO BUILDING 6 TO DELIVER ANOTHER PASS. [REDACTED] WAS TELLING ME ABOUT THE PARTY SHE WAS PLANNING FOR HER FRIEND WHO WAS COMING FROM COLLEGE. [REDACTED] SAID "WE ARE GOING TO RENT A HOTEL ROOM AND GET FUCKED UP. WE ARE GOING TO BRING A FEW BOTTLES AND SOME GUYS ARE GOING TO HAVE SOME CRIP." [REDACTED] SAID SHE WOULD CALL ME. ONCE WE MADE OUR DELIVERIES IN BUILDING 6, [REDACTED] HAD A PASS TO LEAVE SCHOOL FOR THE DAY.

ONCE I WAS DONE WITH MY LAST DELIVERY OF A PASS, I WENT BACK TO THE DEAN'S OFFICE.

[REDACTED] HAD ON A BLACK T SHIRT, KAHKI SHORTS AND BLACK SNEAKERS. I DID POSITIVELY IDENTIFY THE XANAX BARS THROUGH DRUG IDENTIFICATION BIBLE, 2004-2005. THE BAR HAD THE MARKINGS GG249 AND HAS THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT OF ALPRAZOLAM, 2MG, A GENERIC BRAND MANUFACTURED BY GENEVA PHARMACEUTICALS.

I SUBMITTED THE XANAX BARS (15 BARS, 4.2 GRAMS) INTO EVIDENCE AFTER I PACKAGED THEM INTO AN EVIDENCE BAG. THIS CASE REMAINS OPEN PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATION.
