FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's parents were notified by the Principal of Palm Beach Maritime Academy that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on April 8, 2005. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parents were notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on May 13, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parents of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. Respondent's parents requested an administrative hearing. This hearing was held on October 12, 2005 and the Recommended Order is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit C).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated May 13, 2005, to wit:

Possession of a knife while on the campus of Palm Beach Maritime Academy on
March 30, 2005.

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed.  is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from April 14, 2005. Respondent may choose to continue educational services during his expulsion

period at the ACS site. However, if Respondent is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

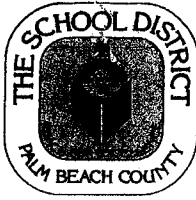

NOTICE OF RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION



Dear Mr. and Mrs.

Based upon the recommendation of the Board Members of the Palm Beach Maritime Academy, and in accordance with Florida Statute § 1006.07, and Palm Beach County School Board Policy 5.1813, I will request that the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, expel your son from the Palm Beach County School District. This decision is based upon the following action:

Possession of a knife while on the campus of Palm Beach Maritime Academy on March 30, 2005.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.569, you have the right to an administrative hearing. Your request must be received by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, a hearing officer will be appointed pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.81(1)(e). If you do not request a hearing, this recommendation will become final.

Your son may receive educational services at the ACS Transition Program during this expulsion due process. If you have any questions regarding the expulsion due process or the educational services available at the ACS Intensive Site, please contact the Office of the Chief Academic Officer at 561-649-6888.


RECOMMENDED ORDER

THIS CAUSE comes before the undersigned Hearing Officer regarding the Petition for Expulsion concerning Respondent, [REDACTED] for the purported violation of School Board Policies 5.18 and/or 5.80, specifically that on March 30, 2005, the respondent did possess a knife while on the campus of Palm Beach Maritime Academy. Present at the hearing was the counsel for the School Board, Iola Mosely Esq. as well as the respondent, his father [REDACTED] and his mother [REDACTED]. After a preliminary discussion between his parents and a general review of how the proceeding would be conducted, it was determined on the record that the respondent stipulated the allegations within the Petition and that these allegations were the basis for the expulsion.

Based upon the foregoing paragraph, the specific allegations set forth within the Petition were read into the record, to which the parents of the Respondent as well as the Respondent admitted to the allegations, thereby obviating the need to take further testimony. Relying upon this stipulation, the undersigned Hearing Officer finds that the

burden of proof has been met, and accordingly must recommend the expulsion of the Respondent.



Subject: Expulsion of Student [REDACTED]

After waiting until 9:20 a.m. for the student and his guardian, who did not appear, the meeting was called to order by the chairman.

Present were John C. Grant, chairman, Dr. Raymond A. Liberti, board member, Marie A. Turchiaro, school principal, Nancy Swenson, asst. principal and Kim Sexton, executive assistant.

The chairman stated that the meeting was being held to review certain actions of [REDACTED] that took place on 3/30/05 wherein this student brought a concealed weapon (a knife) to school with an intent to do harm.

Ray Liberti stated that the principal has provided a file of the incident regarding [REDACTED] Student ID# [REDACTED] to the board who reviewed the incident, read the police and arrest reports and other statements and summaries. He asked the principal to give a synopsis of the incident.

The principal stated that several students reported [REDACTED] had a knife in his possession and was threatening to use it to hurt another student after school. The police investigated and asked [REDACTED] if he had a knife. [REDACTED] repeatedly denied it, but it was inside his sneaker. It looked to be several inches. The officer confiscated it and [REDACTED] was arrested.

Ray Liberti stated that we invited the student and parent to appear at this hearing and it is 9:30 now and they have yet to appear. He referenced the police report #057600 and said that the school administration acted appropriately in an effort to continue our zero tolerance of weaponry for the protection of all other students at the school. He made a motion to expel and not permit the return of [REDACTED] to Palm Beach Maritime Academy, which was seconded by John Grant and carried unanimously.

A motion was made at 9:32 a.m. by Ray Liberti to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by John Grant and carried unanimously to adjourn.


