FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's parent was notified by the Principal of Palm Beach Gardens High School that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on August 18, 2005. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parent was notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on September 2, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parent of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. No hearing request has been received in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated September 2, 2005, to wit:

Possession of other potentially dangerous items while on the campus of Palm Beach Gardens High School on August 18, 2005.

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed. [REDACTED] is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from September 1, 2005. Respondent may choose to continue educational services during his

expulsion period at the ACS site. However, if Respondent is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

On 08/18/2005 your son/daughter was rendered a ten (10) day suspension as documented by my letter to you, a copy of which is attached.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.23(6)(c), which authorizes the School Board to decide cases recommended for expulsion, I have this date recommended to the Expulsion Study Team that the School Board expel your son/daughter from the public schools of Palm Beach County. My recommendation is based on substantial evidence available to me supporting the following serious misconduct in which your son/daughter was involved:


On Wednesday, August 17, 2005, at approximately 6:30 p.m., the Riviera Beach Police Department notified PBGHS Police Officer James O'Connor that there was a shooting at the home of PBGHS student [redacted]. The police indicated that the possible alleged suspect was PBGHS student [redacted]. Student [redacted] from they could not find the night of the shooting.

On Thursday, August 18, 2005, at approximately 8:00 a.m., PBGHS Police Officer's James O'Connor and Keith Parsons, went to the classroom of PBGHS student [redacted]. Student [redacted] whose name was mentioned by [redacted] during Police questioning regarding a Riviera Beach shooting the night before. The Officer's brought [redacted] to the police office where the officer's asked [redacted] if he had anything on him that he shouldn't [redacted] [redacted] became nervous and began fidgeting with his waistband. The officer's then searched [redacted] and found a plastic gun taped to his stomach with electrical tape. The plastic gun was altered to look like a real 38 caliber handgun, it was covered with black tape and had tin foil on the trigger. [redacted] was released into the custody of his mother.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 230.33(8), the Superintendent may extend the ten (10) day suspension until the date the School Board Meeting at which time the School Board will act on the Expulsion.

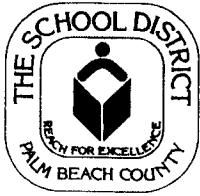
As of 08/01/2005, [redacted] is assigned to the Department of Alternative Education.

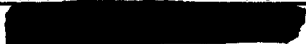

NOTICE OF RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION



Dear Mr. and Mrs. 

Based upon the recommendation of Jon Prince, Principal of Palm Beach Gardens High School, and in accordance with Florida Statute § 1006.07, and Palm Beach County School Board Policy 5.1813, I will request that the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, expel your son,  from the Palm Beach County School District. This decision is based upon the following action:

Possession of other potentially dangerous items while on the campus of Palm Beach Gardens High School on August 18, 2005.

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.569, you have the right to an administrative hearing. Your request must be received by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, a hearing officer will be appointed pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.81(1)(e). If you do not request a hearing, this recommendation will become final.

Your son may receive educational services at the ACS Transition Program during this expulsion due process. If you have any questions regarding the expulsion due process or the educational services available at the ACS Intensive Site, please contact the Office of the Chief Academic Officer at 561-649-6888.

On 08/17/2005 at approximately 1900 hours, I was called by Detective Sean Alex of the Riviera Beach Police Department. Det. Alex told me that he was responding to a drive by shooting at [redacted] Riviera Beach, FL. Det. Alex told me that the intended victim was [redacted] a student at Palm Beach Gardens High School. Det. Alex asked that I respond to his station to assist him in the investigation. On my arrival to the Riviera Beach Police Dept., Det. Alex told me that an unknown subject fired several shots at the residence with an unknown caliber handgun. [redacted] told him that he [redacted] into an argument with [redacted] [redacted] during the lunch hour at Palm Beach Gardens High School on 08/17/2005. [redacted] felt that the drive by was in retaliation for the argument with [redacted] Riviera Beach Police were unable to make contact with [redacted]. I checked school records on [redacted] and discovered that he was also enrolled at Palm Beach Gardens High School. I notified Lt. Brewer of the situation, and also briefed Ofc. K. Parson, who is assigned at Palm Beach Gardens High School. Although [redacted] was a suspect, Det. Alex did not have probable cause for his arrest.

Det. Matt Williams and I responded to Palm Beach Gardens High School on 08/18/2005 in an attempt to make contact with [redacted]. Upon our arrival, we met with Ofc. Parson, who had already detained [redacted] as he got off of his bus. Parson told me that he had recovered a silver Marksman BB gun (serial # 05124393) from [redacted] book bag. I notified Det. Alex that [redacted] was being detained and he responded to Palm Beach Gardens High School to interview [redacted]. During the interview, [redacted] stated that he had gotten into a fight with [redacted] during a football game in 2004. [redacted] who is [redacted] cousin became involved when he tried to defend [redacted]. [redacted] said that ever since the fight, there has been friction between he and [redacted]. [redacted] denied any involvement in the shooting on 08/17/2005. I asked [redacted] why he brought the BB gun to school, and he told me that [redacted] had threatened him with a "chopper" (street terminology commonly used to describe a firearm or machine gun). [redacted] felt that he could apparently defend himself with his BB gun.

It was discovered during the investigation that another student, [redacted] who is a friend of [redacted], may have been involved in the incident. [redacted] was escorted to the Police Office and interviewed. During the interview, [redacted] kept reaching for the front of his pants, and was patted down for Officer Safety by Ofc. J. O'Connor. Ofc. O'Connor recovered a plastic .38 caliber toy gun from the front of [redacted] waistband.

[redacted] was called to the police office to determine his involvement in the case. During the interview, [redacted] gave Officers consent to search his car that was on campus. During the search, Ofc. O'Connor recovered a small lighter which was a replica of a semi-automatic handgun and a black folding clip knife. There was no indication that [redacted] had brought the knife to school to use it for any reason, therefore he was not charged.

The information above was relayed to Palm Beach Gardens High School Staff for administrative action. Det. Alex was also made aware of the above information.

At the time of this report, Riviera Beach Police Department had no active suspects in the shooting that occurred on 08/17/2005

This case is closed.

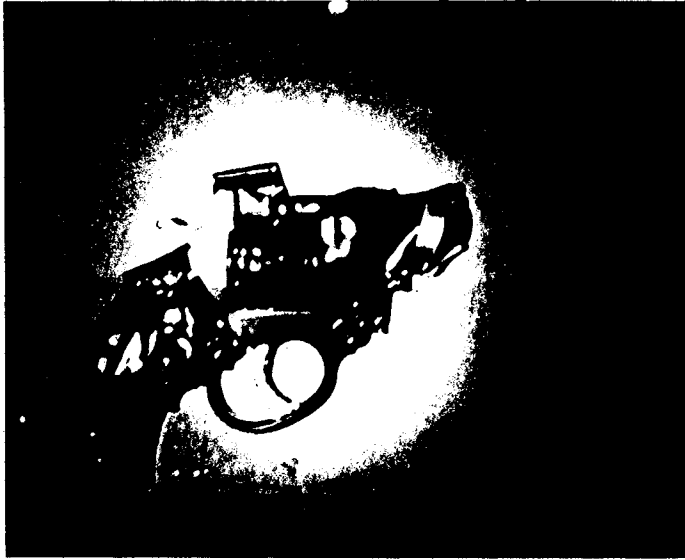

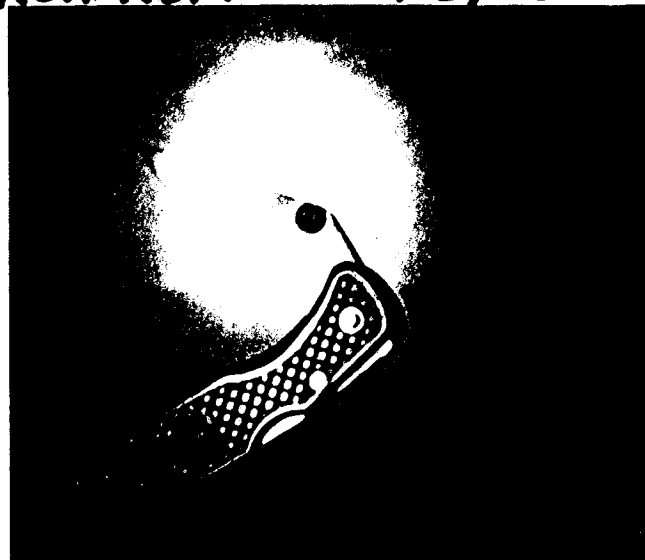

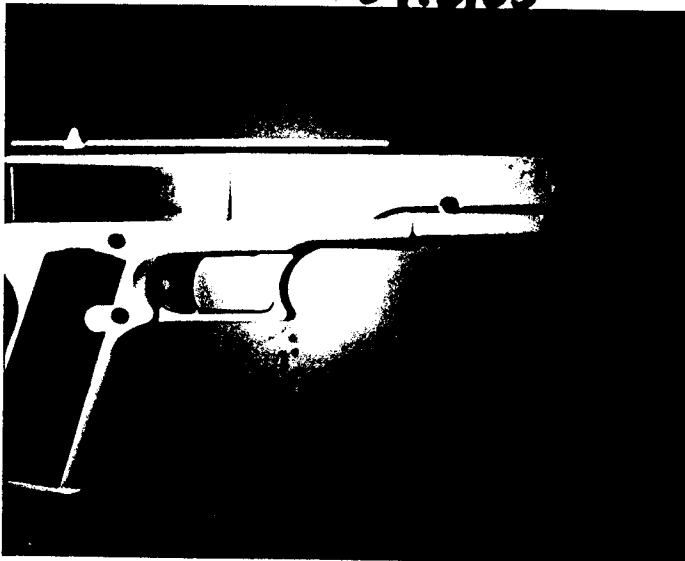
