FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came to be heard by the School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida, ("School Board") for the purpose of entering a Final Order in the above-styled cause. In consideration of the Recommendation of the Superintendent and the attached exhibits, the School Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's parents were notified by the Principal of Palm Beach Lakes Community High School that the Respondent was being recommended for expulsion on October 7, 2005. The Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit A).
2. Respondent's parents were notified by the Superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School District") on November 15, 2005, via certified and regular mail, that the Respondent would be recommended to the School Board to be expelled from the School District. The Notice of Recommendation for Expulsion is incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as (Exhibit B).
3. Said notice advised Respondent's parents of their right to an administrative hearing to contest the charges contained therein provided they requested a hearing within ten (10) days of receipt of same.
4. No hearing request has been received in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The School Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto.
2. The School Board finds that the Respondent is guilty of the acts alleged by the Superintendent in the letter dated November 15, 2005, to wit:

Sale and/or distribution of drugs/imitation/prescription while on the campus of
Palm Beach Lakes Community High School on September 26, 2005.

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the School Board in regular session that the recommendation of the Superintendent be accepted and confirmed.  is hereby expelled from the School District for one calendar year from October 13, 2006. Respondent may choose to continue educational services during his

expulsion period at the ACS site. However, if Respondent is dismissed from that program by ACS, no further educational services will be offered by the District until the expulsion period is ended.

This Order may be appealed within thirty (30) days by filing a notice of appeal with the District Court of Appeal. Except in cases of indigence, the Court will require a filing fee and payment for preparing the record on appeal. For further explanation of the right to appeal, refer to § 120.68, Fla. Stat., and the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

Dear Custodial Parent/Guardian:

On 09/27/2005, your son was rendered a ten (10) day suspension as documented by my letter to you, a copy of which is attached.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §230.23(6)(c), which authorizes the School Board to decide cases recommended for expulsion, I have this date recommended to the Expulsion Screening Committee that the School Board expel your son from the public schools of Palm Beach County. My recommendation is based on substantial evidence available to me supporting the following serious misconduct.

CASE # 05-2791

SALE/DISTRIBUTION OF DRUGS – Student was charged by School Police as being in possession of drugs. Three (3) bags of marijuana (under 20 grams) with intent to sell within 1000 feet of school grounds.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §230.33(8), the Superintendent may extend the ten (10) day suspension until the date the School Board Meeting at which time the School Board will act on the Expulsion.

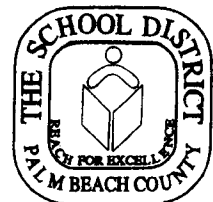

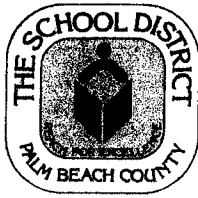

NOTICE OF RECOMMENDATION FOR EXPULSION

Pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.569, you have the right to an administrative hearing. Your request must be received by the Office of the Chief Academic Officer within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, a hearing officer will be appointed pursuant to Florida Statute § 120.81(1)(e). If you do not request a hearing, this recommendation will become final.

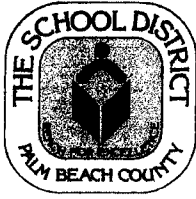



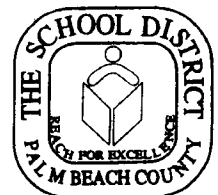

CONFERENCE NOTES FREDDY PIERRE-PAUL

Please be advised that I, Nathan Collins, met with the father of [REDACTED] in the School Police Officer's office and discussed all of the ramifications regarding his son having brought the marijuana onto campus. I explained to the father that his son had been suspended ten (10) days and that I would recommend to the Superintendent that he be expelled from the Palm Beach County School District for distribution of marijuana on school board property. I also explained to the father that last school term we suspected that he was selling drugs on campus but could not find proof. At the start of this school year, the same issues were suspected by one of our Assistant Principals, Mr. Roy Brown. We contacted the family regarding this issue. Upon conclusion of my conference, I told the father that he had the right to appeal the expulsion recommended to the School District of Palm Beach County upon receipt of the letter of recommendation for expulsion.



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NARRATIVE FREDDY PIERRE-PAUL

On 9/26/05, the parent of [REDACTED] came to my office along with her daughter. The student, [REDACTED] had brought some suspected marijuana home and her mother, [REDACTED] had found it. After speaking with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the head dean, Mr. Roy Brown, and myself attempted to locate the student, [REDACTED] who had given the suspected marijuana to [REDACTED] to sell on Monday, 9/19/05.

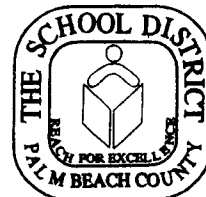
Mr. Brown went to room 216 and asked the teacher, Mrs. Evadney Ellis, if [REDACTED] was in class. When [REDACTED] got up to exit the room he dropped a small aluminum foil packet on the floor from his right front pocket, as observed by Mr. Brown. Mrs. Ellis told [REDACTED] to pick the packet up, which he did. He put it in his front right pocket and exited the room. At that time Mr. Brown asked him to turn the packet over to him. It was a small aluminum foil packet with three small clear bags inside which contained a green leafy substance (suspected marijuana). Mr. Brown escorted [REDACTED] to the deans' office (Mrs. Johnson's) where I met him. No other property was recovered. Mr. Brown turned the three bags of suspected marijuana and aluminum foil over to Officer Anderson. At that time [REDACTED] was handcuffed and taken to Officer Anderson's office for processing. Miranda rights were given and the student and he stated that he understood all the rights as read to him. [REDACTED] stated he admitted to selling marijuana on school grounds, possessing marijuana on school grounds, and giving it to another student to sell on school grounds. The three bags recovered from [REDACTED] weighed approximately 4.40 grams with packaging. The bags were field tested and yielded a positive test result for the presence of THC.

On 09/26/05 at approximately 0900 hours I was called to the principal's office, Mr. Nathan Collins, reference to a parent and student. The student, [REDACTED] had brought some suspected marijuana home and her mother, [REDACTED] had found it.

According to [REDACTED], she walked up to a male student that she only knows by his first name ([REDACTED]) and asked him if she could sell drugs for him, so that she could make money to help her family out. [REDACTED] said she got the marijuana about a week ago, on the 22nd of September, four bags. [REDACTED] said she was to sell the bags of marijuana for \$5.00 a piece. [REDACTED] said she was given the marijuana in front of the lecture hall, the same week [REDACTED] showed her a wad (large amount) of money, he told her that he sells drugs, so she asked him if she could sell for him.

By this time, [REDACTED] handed me a white envelope with four small clear bags, containing a green leafy substance. The bags had small green faces on them, just like the bags recovered in case # 05-2778.

Mr. Collins called for Mrs. Robin Johnson, a school dean, to assist him with [REDACTED]. He wanted her to identify [REDACTED]'s picture, which Dean Johnson located in the student photos on the computer. [REDACTED] was able to positively identify [REDACTED] as the student who had given her the suspected marijuana to sell.

Due to the fact that [REDACTED] brought the drugs to the school to deal with a situation she felt involved the school and because she was concerned about her daughter and wanted the schools help, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are not being charged with possession of marijuana on school grounds. The charge of possession for [REDACTED] is unfounded due to the fact that she was not seen in constructive possession of the suspected marijuana on school grounds and [REDACTED] only brought the property (the four bags of suspected marijuana) to school because she did not know what else to do with it. The four bags of suspected marijuana weighed approximately 5.50 grams; it was placed into school police evidence.

Mr. Collins talked with [REDACTED] and stated that he would work with her and her daughter administratively. The charge of possession of marijuana is unfounded and this case is cleared with no further action taken.
