


CAREGIVING YOUTH PROJECT (CYP) COMPARATIVE RESULTS 2013-14 vs. 2015-16 End of Year Feedback – How CYP Helped Student-Caregivers



Palm Beach County students (n=292) completed the End of the Year Feedback Form at the end of the 2013-14 school year and 336 students two years later. For both years there were about 20% more female and middle school respondents. Not all students answered all questions. Some student respondents answered via telephone interview. Students who entered the CYP during the final school quarter were not invited to complete the Form. CYP services are needs-driven; not all students receive the same support or opportunities to meet other caregiving youths. Qualitative results are also available.
