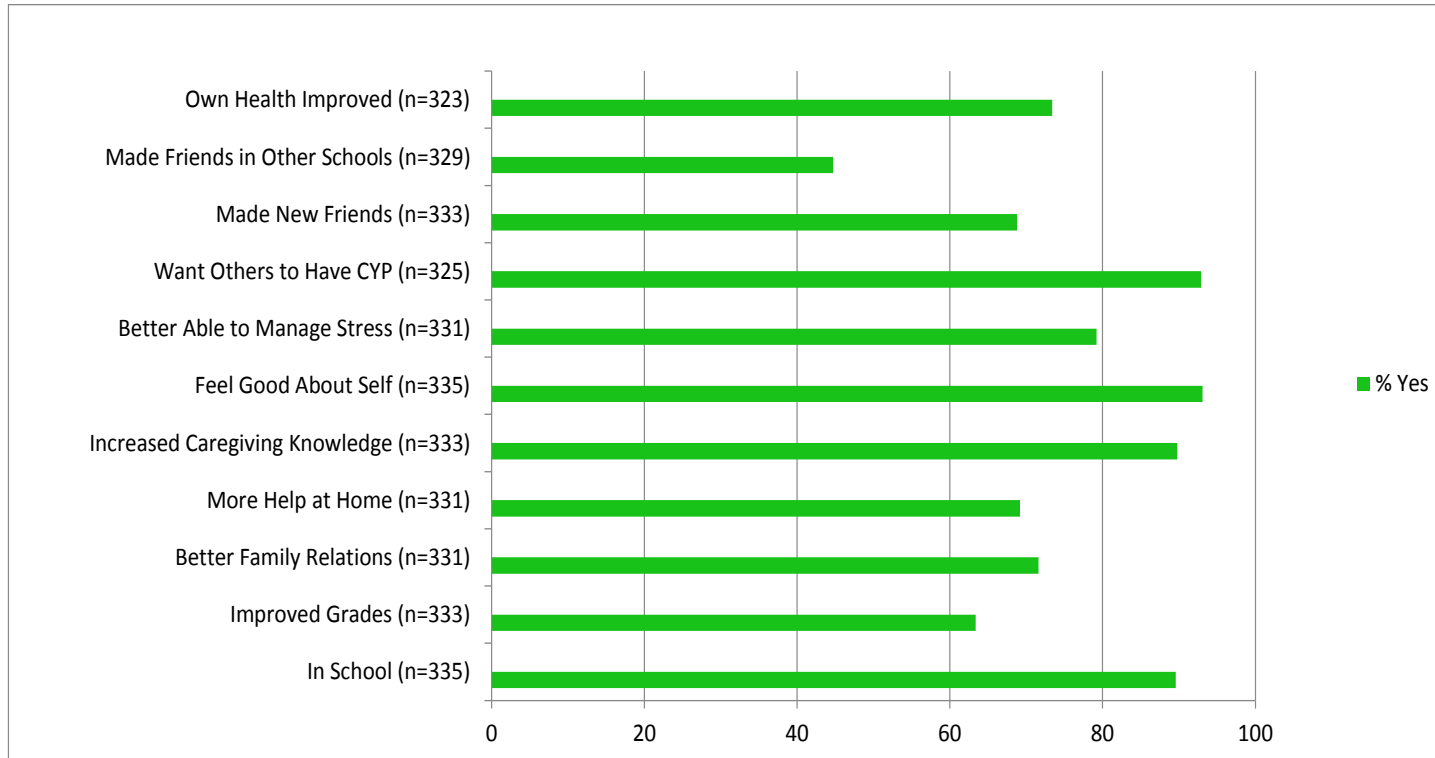




## CAREGIVING YOUTH PROJECT (CYP) RESULTS 2015-16 End of Year Feedback – How CYP Helped Student-Caregivers



A total of 336 students completed the End of the Year Feedback Form at the end of the 2015-16 school year. Respondents were 65.4% female (n=220) and 60.4% were in middle school. Not all students responded to all questions. Some student respondents answered via telephone interview. Students who entered the Caregiving Youth Project during the final school quarter were not invited to complete the End of Year Feedback Form. CYP services provided are needs-driven so not all students received the same supports or had the same opportunities to meet caregiving youth from other schools. Qualitative results are also available.
