SUBJECT: FY2008 FCAT Writing+ Test Results for All Students Tested

On May 8, 2008, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the results of the FCAT Writing+ Test for all students tested.¹ Approximately 36,500 students in the School District of Palm Beach County (SDPBC) took the FCAT Writing+ Test in February 2008 at grades 4, 8, and 10.

A preliminary statistical analysis of the percent of students scoring 3.5 and above² revealed that the SDPBC (1) continues to outperform the State and (2) showed significant improvement at the secondary level. Specifically,

- In FY2008, the SDPBC continued to perform higher than the State at grade 4 (85% vs. 77%), grade 8 (91% vs. 88%), and grade 10 (82% vs. 78%);
- The degree to which the SDPBC outperformed the State was greater in FY2008 than in FY2007 at all grades, and has steadily increased at grade 4 since FY2004.
- Percents for the SDPBC increased from FY2007 to FY2008 at grade 8 (86% to 91%), and were similar at grade 4 (85% to 85%) and grade 10 (81% to 82%);
- Percents for the State increased slightly from FY2007 to FY2008 at grade 8 (86% to 88%), and were similar at grade 4 (78% to 77%) and grade 10 (79% to 78%);

Results for the SDPBC and the State of Florida are attached. Schools have received their Writing+ scores and will use this information in the school improvement planning process. These results will also be shared with appropriate staff to provide direction for improvements in curriculum and instruction.

¹ The Writing+ test in FY2008 consisted of essay and multiple choice sections. However, the multiple choice section is not reported here as it will not be used for the FY2008 school grades and will not be administered in FY2009. This summary is based on all students tested, not on the group of students used in the calculation of school grades or AYP. The FDOE has not provided disaggregated data at this time.
