SUBJECT: RELEASE OF FY2007 GRADES 5, 8, AND 11 FCAT SSS SCIENCE: ALL

STUDENTS TESTED

The Florida Department of Education has released the results for the FY2007 FCAT SSS Science test for all students tested. Approximately 36,000 SDPBC students took the FCAT SSS Science Test in March 2007 at grades 5, 8, and 11.

Overall, the SDPBC has shown considerable improvement in all grades tested. A statistical analysis of the test results follows:

- From FY2006 to FY2007, the SDPBC and the State have improved at all grades tested in the percent of students at Level 1 and at Level 3 and higher.
- In FY2007, the SDPBC performed better than the State in grades 5, 8, and 11 in the percent of students at Level 3 and higher, and in grades 5 and 11 in the percent of students at Level 1.

The attached tables report the FY2006 and FY2007 results for the SDPBC and the State.2 Table 1 reports the percent of proficient students (those scoring at Level 3 and above), and Table 2 reports the percent of low-performing students (those scoring at Level 1). These results will be shared with appropriate staff to provide direction for improvements in curriculum and instruction. Also, schools have received information about their FCAT Science test takers and will use this information in the school improvement planning process.
