**SUBJECT: RELEASE OF FY2006 REPORT CARD FOR SCHOOLS**

Today, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the 2006 Annual Report Card for schools. This document reports State of Florida A+ Plan school grades as well as Federal No Child Left Behind Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) results. The 2006 Annual Report Card is located at <http://schoolgrades.fldoe.org>.

A review of the 2006 Annual Report Card data for schools in the School District of Palm Beach County (SDPBC)<sup>1</sup> is summarized in the attached tables and reveals the following:

### School Grades

- For the last four years, no regular SDPBC school has received a grade of "F". The SDPBC is the only large urban district in Florida<sup>2</sup> that has achieved this distinction.
- From FY2005 to FY2006, SDPBC middle schools receiving a grade of "A" increased 14 percentage points; high schools increased nearly eight percentage points; elementary schools stayed about the same.
- From FY2005 to FY2006, 19% of SDPBC schools improved at least one letter grade.

### AYP

- In FY2006, both the SDPBC and Florida had 28% of schools making AYP.
- From FY2005 to FY2006, SDPBC middle schools making AYP increased three percentage points; high schools stayed the same; alternative and elementary schools decreased by 11 and 22 percentage points respectively<sup>3</sup>.

When reviewing the summary statements and attached tables and graphs, note that rule changes have affected school grades and AYP calculations. These changes include the following:

<sup>1</sup> Charter schools are not included in the analysis of school grades or AYP. Because alternative schools did not receive grades in FY2006, they are not included in the analysis of school grades. As they received AYP status, however, they are included in the AYP analysis.

<sup>2</sup> The seven large urban districts are Broward, Dade, Duval, Hillsboro, Orange, Palm Beach and Pinellas.

<sup>3</sup> The AYP standard for success increased from 37% passing to 44% passing in reading and from 44% to 50% in mathematics.

- 1) In FY2001, school grades were determined by measuring proficiency in reading, writing, and math in grades 4, 5, 8, and 10.
- 2) In FY2002, learning gains were added to the school grades formula for grades 3-10.
- 3) In FY2005, Exceptional Student Education (ESE) and limited English proficient (LEP) students were added to learning gains calculations in the school grade formula for grades 3-10.
- 4) In FY2005, the criteria for determining AYP status was applied to subgroups whose population was greater than or equal to 30 and at least 15% of the total school population OR at least 100 students in the subgroup count.
- 5) Beginning in FY2006, Reading and Mathematics were calculated separately to determine the participation for AYP. Also, in FY2006, alternative education schools were not graded. Finally, the AYP standard for success increased from 37% passing to 44% passing in reading and from 44% to 50% in mathematics.
