SUBJECT: RELEASE OF THE FY2007 ANNUAL REPORT CARD

On June 27, 2007, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the 2007 Annual Report Card. This document reports State of Florida A+ Plan school grades as well as Federal No Child Left Behind Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) results. The Florida 2007 Annual Report Card is located at <http://schoolgrades.fdoe.org>.

The State has periodically increased expectations for school performance. Since 1995, the standards have been raised four times, including the addition of the following indicators in FY2007:

- Percent of students receiving Level 3 or higher in science;
- Learning gains in the lowest 25% in mathematics,
- High school bonus points for grade 11 and 12 FCAT retakes.

A review of the 2007 Annual Report Card data for the School District of Palm Beach County (SDPBC)¹ revealed the following.

District Grades

- The SDPBC continues its standard of high performance by maintaining a district grade of "A" for the third consecutive year. The SDPBC is the only large urban district in Florida² to achieve this distinction (see Table A).
- The SDPBC is one of only 19 school districts in Florida to receive a district grade of "A" in FY2007 (see Table B)

District AYP

- For the third consecutive year, the SDPBC has achieved the improved graduation rate and increased performance in writing as required³ for AYP.
- From FY2006 to FY2007, the SDPBC increased the percentage of AYP criteria met from 79% to 85%, which included improvements in proficiency in mathematics for Blacks and English Language Learners.

¹ Charter schools are included in the analysis of District grades and AYP, but are not included in the analysis of school grades.

² The seven large urban districts are determined by student enrollment

³ AYP requires at least a 1% improvement in writing and a 1% increase in graduation rate.

School Grades

- In FY2007, the SDPBC had a higher percentage of schools receiving a grade of "A" (63%) than the State (52%).⁴
- From FY2003 to FY2007, the percentage of SDPBC elementary schools receiving a grade of "A" increased 24 percentage points; high schools increased 17 percentage points; and middle schools increased about eight percentage points.
- In FY2007, SDPBC schools had a lower percentage of schools receiving a grade of "D" or "F" (8%) than the State (11%).
- In FY2007, 44% of SDPBC high schools received bonus points for grade 11 and 12 FCAT retakes⁵; this is one of the highest percentages among the seven large urban school districts in Florida (see Table C).

School AYP

- From FY2006 to FY2007, the percentage of SDPBC elementary, middle, and high schools making AYP increased from 32% to 38%.
- From FY2006 to FY2007, a total of 19 SDPBC elementary, middle, and high schools (12%) moved from AYP status of "No" to "Yes", and only nine schools (6%) moved from AYP status of "Yes" to "No".

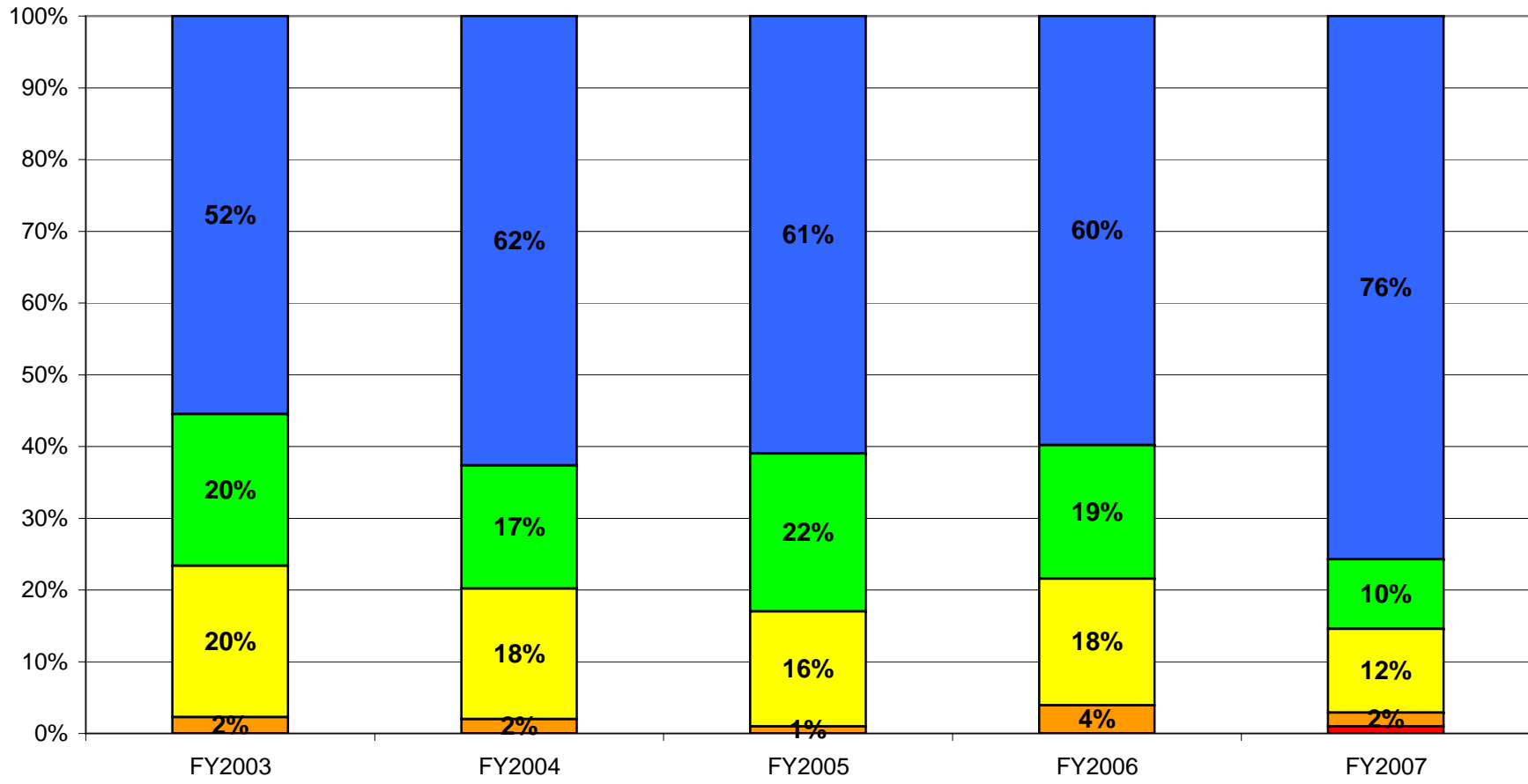

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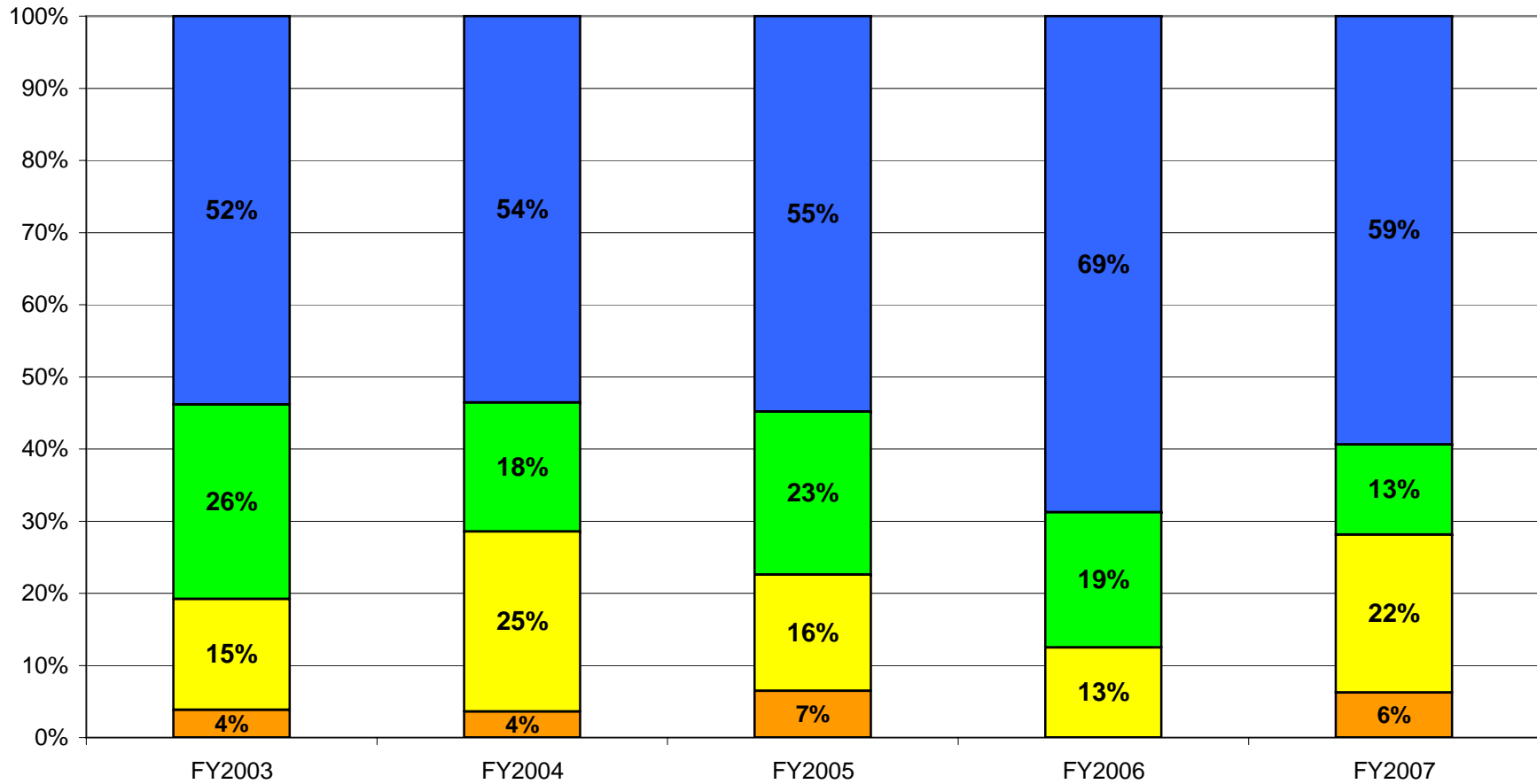
School District of Palm Beach County ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GRADES FY2003 - FY2007

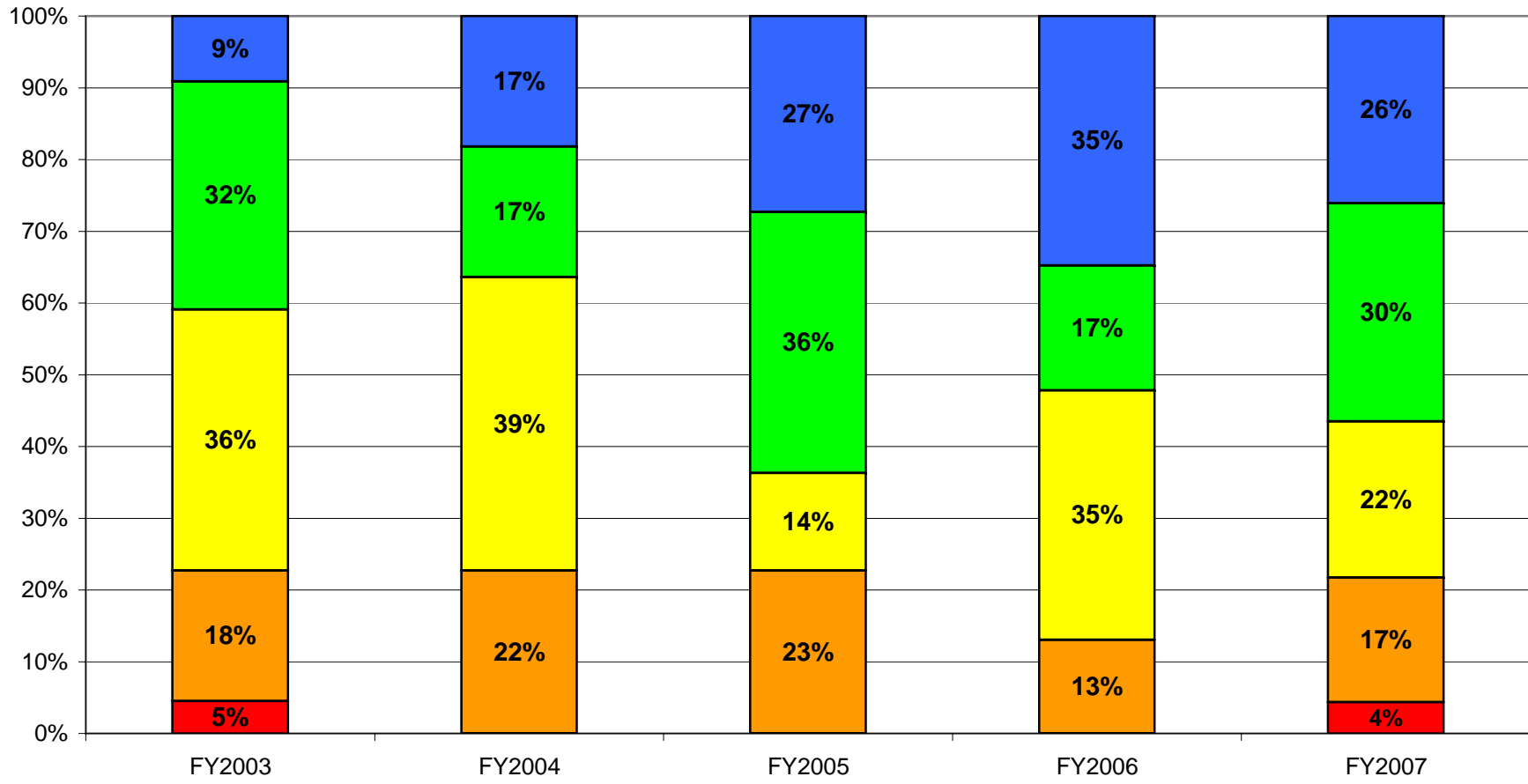
School District of Palm Beach County MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADES FY2003 - FY2007
